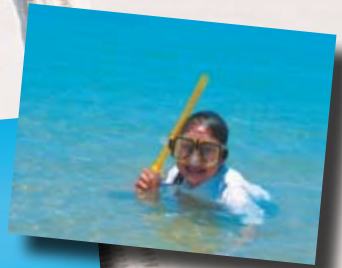
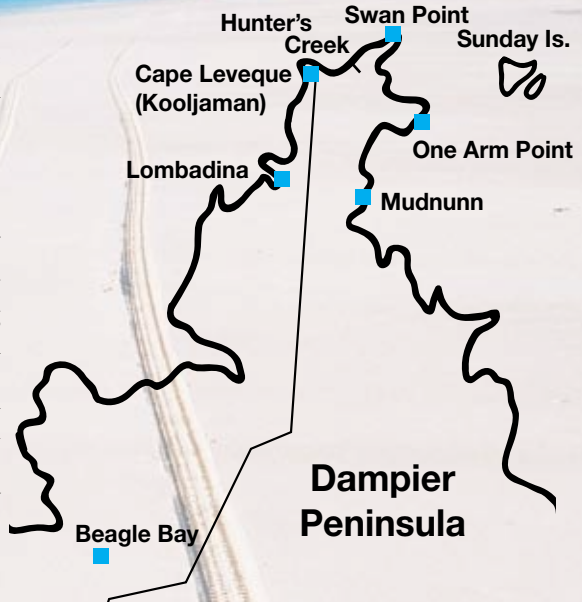

Welcome to Chomley's Tours - the Cape Leveque specialist. Enhance your visit to the north with a tour to the Dampier Peninsula with Roger Chomley and his team. One or two day options are available regularly, or extended charters can be organised for those who would like to spend more time in the area. Good quality camping equipment and catering is provided, all complemented by excellent and informative interpretation of this fascinating area. The opportunity to participate in local aboriginal guided tours is also provided so that you leave the area with a greater appreciation of the lifestyle of the Peninsula people. These local tours include one, two or three of the following activities: sea kayaking, snorkelling, shore fishing, reef walking and mudcrabbing.



ONE DAY CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing!

Experience Cape Leveque in a day. This tour includes a visit to the Beagle Bay Aboriginal Community and the beautiful Sacred Heart Church, famous for its pearl shell altar. At low tide search for mud crabs in the mangroves and on the open intertidal flats along the coastline near Mudnunn with local guide Vincent Angus. Cook and sample what we catch. Enjoy a leisurely lunch on a pristine beach north of the cape where swimming, walking, fossicking for shells or relaxing is spread over 1.5 hours. 4WD down to the red cliffs of Cape Leveque. Returning to Broome we stop at the Lombadina Aboriginal Community where you have the opportunity to purchase traditional handcrafted work and view the bush style community church.

WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off from your Broome accommodation. Times will be advised upon booking. Morning tea, Lunch and Afternoon tea. Vegetarian meals catered for with prior notification. Cordial and cold water. Comfortable chairs and shade at lunch stop on the beach. Community entry fees, 1 hour mud crabbing tour and reef shoes for mud crabbing.

WHAT TO BRING?

Broad rimmed hat, swimming costume and towel, all round walking shoes/sandals for land and water. Sun protection, i.e. long sleeves shirt, insect repellent, sunglasses and camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial.

ONE DAY DRIVE/FLY CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing!



This tour includes all the highlights of the One Day Cape Leveque tour with mud crabbing (provided low tide is in the morning) and returns you to Broome before sunset. After the 4WD down to Red Cliffs passengers board the plane at the Cape Leveque airstrip (excludes visit to Lombadina). Fly (50 minutes) directly over the Dampier Peninsula to Broome with aerial views of Lombadina, Beagle Bay, Willie Creek, Cable Beach and the township of Broome. Alternatively take a longer flight (90 minutes) over King Sound to the Horizontal Falls and deserted islands of the Buccaneer Archipelago before returning diagonally across the Dampier Peninsula to Broome.

WHAT'S INCLUDED?

The same as the One Day Cape Leveque with mud crabbing plus flight and taxi from Broome airport to accommodation at the end of the tour.

WHAT TO BRING?

The same as the One Day Cape Leveque with mud crabbing tour. Make sure water bottle is full before boarding 90 minute flight.

TWO DAY CAPE LEVEQUE



Hunters Creek

Includes all the highlights of Day Tour with mud crabbing and an overnight stay at Kooljaman Resort in comfortable tents with stretcher beds. The first day ends with optional self-guided sunset coastal walk around the beautiful red cliffs of Cape Leveque before a BBQ dinner.

PLUS: An enlightening morning on a 4WD tag-along tour with Tara Hunter. This tour involves a trip along the coastline north of Hunter's Creek to Swan Point visiting areas that are normally 'off limits' to self drivers. Enjoy some coastal fishing and reef walking (tide dependent) followed by swimming and snorkelling. Morning tea is enjoyed under the shade of a tree beside a little protected bay below Swan Point. Cook what we catch over a camp fire 'local style' and take the opportunity to talk with Tara about the lifestyle of the Bardi people. After lunch at Cape Leveque you visit the aboriginal community of Lombadina which includes a swim at their beautiful beach before heading back to Broome.

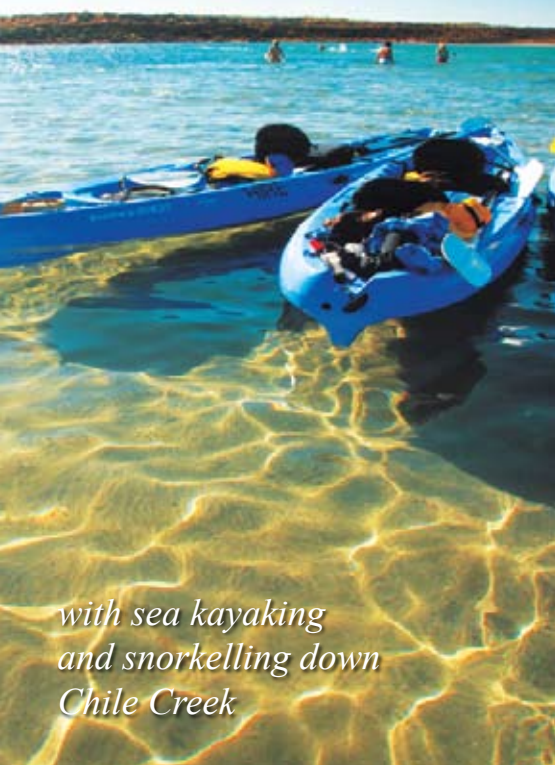
WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off included. Times will be advised upon booking. Comfortable two man (high roof) tent, stretcher beds, mattress, fresh linen, sleeping bag & pillow. Clean showers and toilets in the Resort. Day 1: Morning Tea, Lunch/Dinner. Day 2: Breakfast, Morning Tea/Lunch. Any dietary requirements MUST be advised when booking. All entry fees, aboriginal tours, fishing gear/bait, reef shoes for mud crabbing.

WHAT TO BRING?

Broad rimmed hat, swimming costume and towel, all round walking shoes/sandals for land and water, sun protection i.e. long sleeves shirt. Sunglasses, water bottle, camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial. BYO alcohol.

THREE DAY CAPE LEVEQUE TOUR



*with sea kayaking
and snorkelling down
Chile Creek*

This tour includes all the highlights of the One Day tour with mud crabbing and Two Day tour with tag-along trip to Swan Point and an extra nights camping at Kooljaman Resort.

PLUS: Go for an eventful 3 hour paddle with Robert Sibosado on the tidal estuary of Chile Creek just south of Lombadina. This tour only operates with the larger spring tides (see time table below) so that you go down the estuary with the falling tide and then come back up the estuary with the rising tide. Along the way see stingrays and fish swimming underneath your kayak. At low tide snorkel in still lagoons at the mouth of the estuary and find turtles. After lunch visit Lombadina beach and the aboriginal community before heading back to Broome.

The same as per the Two Day Cape Leveque tour plus: Day 2: Dinner. Day 3: Breakfast, Morning Tea/ Lunch. Sea kayaks, life jackets and snorkelling equipment and water proof bags.

WHAT TO BRING?

The same as the Two Day Cape Leveque Tour.

FOUR DAY CAPE LEVEQUE

Looking for an extended stay at an affordable price try our 4 Day Option.



This trip starts with the two day tour leaving Tuesday. After lunch on Wednesday you are left at Kooljaman to do your own thing for the rest of the afternoon. On Thursday you can relax on the beach, go for walks or participate in optional activities such as a scenic flight over the Buccaneer Archipelago or a boat trip around the Kooljaman coast (ring Kooljaman office – 08 9192 4970 for availability). On Friday the day is yours until 3.00 pm where upon you will be picked up from the Kooljaman office and return to Broome via Lombadina with Friday's one day passengers. Ask about staying in a beach shelter or safari tent for that extra special experience.

WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off included. Times will be advised upon booking. Chairs, table, two man (high roof) tent, stretcher beds, mattresses, fresh linen, pillow. Gas burner, cooking utensils, cutlery, plates, bowls, cups, wash basin and freezer box to keep things cold (ice can be purchased from resort). All entry fees, fishing gear/bait. Tuesday: Morning tea, lunch and dinner. Wednesday: Breakfast and lunch. Thursday: Breakfast. Friday: Breakfast and afternoon tea. From April to October meals not catered for can be purchased from Dinkas Café at your own expense (please make dinner bookings before arriving by ringing the Kooljaman office on 08 9192 4970) or bring your own food.

WHAT TO BRING?

The same as per Two Day Cape Leveque tour and another change of clothing. BYO alcohol. None can be purchased at Kooljaman.

Dampier Peninsula Transfers

One way transfers are available to or from Cape Leveque. Pick-ups can also be arranged from Beagle Bay or Lombadina. From Broome to Cape Leveque transfers are available Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. Departure 6.45 am - 7.00 am with arrival Cape Leveque 11.30 am – 1.00 am. From Cape Leveque to Broome transfers are available Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Return transfers depart Leveque 3.15 pm, arrival Broome 8.30 pm. Transfer includes mud crabbing tour if trip coincides with low tide and morning or afternoon tea.

Roger Chomley (Driver/guide) lives in Broome and has guided on the Dampier Peninsula for 5 years after working in Central Australia. He provides a keen insight into the plant habitats, history and geology of this diverse coastline and provides a thorough and entertaining commentary on his tours.

Clive Johnson (Driver/guide) lives in Broome and is a keen historian. A Friend of the Historical Society of Broome and an advocate of restoring the Broome Tramway down to Town Beach his tours allow him to share his passion for the area. Prior life to guiding was farm machinery retailer and mechanic. He should get you home if you have a breakdown!

Tara Hunter – Bardi women and local guide for two day tour. Tara lives at One Arm Point where she grew up. She has gained a lot of knowledge through working closely with her father who was a pioneer of local Indigenous tourism. Now guiding in her own right, Tara continues to learn stories for the area from her family who have an outstation near the spectacular Hunter's Creek.

Vincent Angus grew up in Lombadina and moved to the outstation Mudnunn in the early 1990s where he established his mud crabbing tours. Mudnunn is his mother's traditional country whilst his father grew up on the Sunday Island mission. Vincent will work hard in finding that mud crab and help you share in the experience of dragging one out of its hiding spot with a steel hook.

Robert Sibosado (local guide for sea kayaking and snorkelling tours) is a resident of Lombadina and is heavily involved in promoting tourism for his community and the Dampier Peninsula. The sea kayaking provides a unique way of showing his knowledge of the sea which is central to Bardi culture.

VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

Chomley's Tours has 3 vehicles (modified Toyota Landcruiser Troop Carriers) with forward facing seats that can carry a maximum of only 7, 12 and 13 people to ensure a personalized tour. All vehicles have a PA commentary system and are air-conditioned.

A custom built trailer provides easy access and plenty of space for all equipment including your luggage. All vehicles carry a sat phone and first aid kit for emergencies.



Chomley's Tours pride themselves of providing excellent equipment but without charging the earth. Our two man mozzie proof tents are high quality and you can stand upright in them. Beds are raised off the ground stretchers with inflatable comfort mats. Fresh linen, pillow and sleeping bag are provided.

Due to the fact that you will be travelling to remote locations where you will be participating in guided and non-guided activities (i.e. walking, swimming and snorkelling) where mishaps can occur, you are required before paying for your tour to provide emergency contact details and acknowledge by signing the form where indicated, that you have read and accepted the conditions of this tour. This form is to be presented to the tour desk before purchasing your voucher/ticket and handed to your guide with your voucher/ticket upon pickup.

Please note it is felt these tours are not suitable for pregnant women or people with back problems. Depending on the condition of the road we can take up to 7 hours to complete the 460km round trip on the one day tour or 3.5hrs to complete the Broome to Cape Leveque leg.
