This 4WD day tour offers a glimpse into the west Kimberley wilderness: crocodiles, caves, gorges & waterholes...

Departing Broome, travel through Kimberley savannah as our guide

shares stories of local history, people and the environment. After morning tea near the Fitzroy River, visit the notorious Derby 'Boab Prison Tree', believed to be over 1500 years old. Journey along the Gibb River Road

towards the ancient Napier Range – home to a diverse array of animals and plants. Explore the outback oasis of Windjana Gorge searching for freshwater crocodiles, birdlife and bushucker. After a picnic lunch, venture into the Tunnel Creek cave system in which we discover secret caves, spot subterranean wildlife and learn the legend of Jandamarra, an Aboriginal freedom fighter who once

used the tunnel as a hide-out. As dusk approaches, visit the historical ruins of Lillimooloora Station. There is time for dinner (own expense) en route back to Broome. After dark, relax and spot natural savannah fires, before arriving in Broome at approximately 10.00pm.

An easy day tour, combining bus and boat to cruise the waters of majestic Geikie Gorge...

Travel through iconic pindan country, past boab trees, termite mounds and Kimberley cattle. Pause at thousand

year old boab before reaching Geikie Gorge, carved by nature since the Devonian geological period. Swirling floodwaters during the wet season leave colourful marks on the gorge cliffs. The water retreats during the

dry season, yet the flow remains to sustain a variety of Kimberley wildlife. After a picnic lunch, depart on a 2 hour Aboriginal Heritage Cruise or join a National Park Ranger on a 1 hour cruise. Following the cruise, return to Broome stopping en route for dinner (own expense). Arrive at approximately 10.00pm.

Choose your cruise:

1DGG1 Darngku Aboriginal Heritage Cruise

This 2 hour cruise, hosted by local Bunuba Aboriginal guides, provides insight into the Bunuba way of life. Guides demonstrate traditional

techniques for animal tracking and bush medicines, while revealing Dreamtime stories of the area.

1DGG2 National Park Ranger Cruise

On this 1 hour cruise learn of the geology of this ancient Devonian reef and the array of wildlife including freshwater crocodiles, birds and fish.

A 4WD Kimberley adventure that is culturally rewarding in a beautiful environment...

Enjoy morning tea in Beagle Bay, home to the Sacred Heart Church and

its glimmering pearl shell altar. In One Arm Point Community, visit a local aquaculture hatchery and witness the dramatic tidal flows of the Kimberley through the Buccaneer Archipelago.

On Cape Leveque (locally known as Kooljaman) set up by the sea for a picnic lunch. Whether you prefer swimming, sunbathing, walking along the beach or exploring rockpools, there is time to enjoy the area as you please. Depending on the tides, our guide can share with you some of the hidden snorkelling sites or you may prefer to bring a fishing rod or hand line and try your luck – there is always

room in the esky for your catch on the home trip! Returning south, pause in Lombadina Community to see the bush timber church and perhaps pick up a souvenir at the local craft shop. As the sun sets over the Dampier Peninsula, we begin our return journey, arriving back into Broome at approximately 6.30pm.

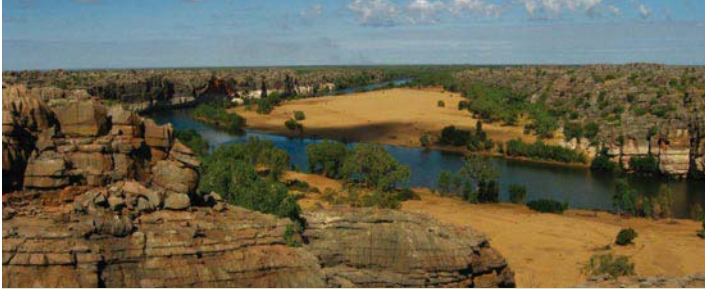

Day 1 Geikie Gorge

In the ancient Napier Range, Geikie Gorge has been carved by nature over 350 million years. The best way to experience this natural wonder is to

join the 2 hour Darrngku Aboriginal Heritage Cruise. Towards sunset, settle in for a BBQ under the Kimberley night sky before retiring to your choice of accommodation: camping (2DGE), Safari Cabin (2DGE1) or Motel Room (2DGE2)*.

Day 2 Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek

In the Tunnel Creek cave system, carved through the Devonian reef, we explore secret caves, see unusual wildlife and learn of legendary local, Jandamarra. A refreshing swim in the waterhole is a highlight so don't forget your swimmers! Lunch at Windjana Gorge then head off to search for freshwater crocodiles, birdlife and bushtucker. En route back to Broome, pause at the ruins of Lillimooloora Station and the Derby 'Boab Prison Tree.' Arrive back at your hotel at approximately 6.30pm.

The Dampier Peninsula blends pristine beaches with traditional Aboriginal culture. Visit Beagle Bay Community, home of the Sacred Heart Church with its glimmering pearl shell altar. At the Kelk Creek Bush Retreat our Aboriginal guide and her family

introduce us to their traditional Bardi 'saltwater country' on a leisurely guided bushwalk. The fresh damper and billy tea at the end of the walk are well worth the wait! Reach Cape Leveque in time to set up camp and enjoy a Kimberley sunset and BBQ under the stars.

Day 2 Cape Leveque

The day at Cape Leveque is yours to enjoy as you please. You may like to join a guided snorkelling or fishing

adventure, or take up one of the many optional extras, including an indigenous sea kayaking adventure or a scenic flight across the archipelago and horizontal falls. Alternatively you may prefer to simply enjoy the beaches and rugged red coastline for which the Cape is famous.

Day 3 Lombadina & One Arm Point

From One Arm Point we can look out across the Buccaneer Archipelago, witness the powerful tidal flows of King Sound and visit the Community's aquaculture hatchery. Enjoy lunch in Lombadina, home to a local craft shop and bush timber church before continuing south to Broome, arriving at approximately 6.30pm.



Combine this trip with an adventure into Kimberley gorge country and to the magnificent Bungle Bungles. Consider the 8 Day Spirit of the Kimberley, page 5.

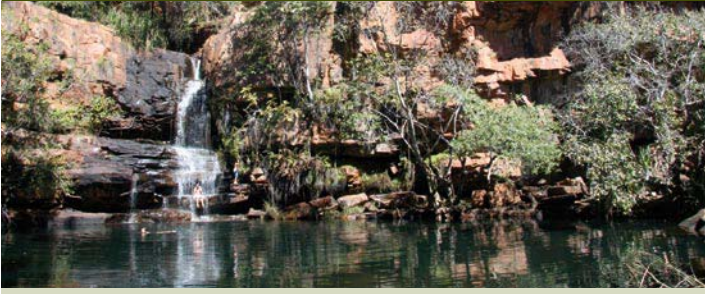

Gorges, waterfalls, walks and swimming: this trip offers a real experience of 'gorge country' for those with limited time...

Day 1 Tunnel Creek

Our experience in the Kimberley gorges begins with a visit to the 'Boab Prison Tree' in Derby, before travelling along the Gibb River Road to the ancient Napier Ranges. The Tunnel Creek cave system is carved through a 350 million year old Devonian reef. Discover secret caverns and unusual subterranean wildlife before a swim in an idyllic waterhole. We also learn the legend of Jandamarra, a 19th Century Aboriginal freedom fighter who used

the Tunnel as a hideout. Towards sunset, settle into our Windjana camp for a BBQ dinner under the sparkling Kimberley night sky.

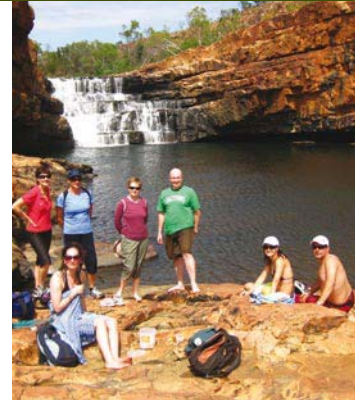
Day 2 Windjana Gorge & Mount Barnett Station

Delve deep into the heart of majestic Windjana Gorge, searching for freshwater crocodiles, birdlife and bushtucker. Travelling further up the Gibb River Road, we pause at Imintji Community for lunch. Freshen up with a swim amongst the water lilies at Galvins Gorge, a pool surrounded by lush remnant rainforest. Camp and enjoy a meal by a shady billabong on Mount Barnett Cattle Station.

Day 3 Manning Falls & Silent Grove
Enjoy a morning trek into Manning Falls through a stunning landscape. Explore wandering streams, encounter wildlife and take a dip in the waterfall pools. In the afternoon, discover tranquil Adcock Gorge before a night at the Silent Grove campsite in the shadow of the King Leopold Ranges.

Day 4 Bell Gorge & Broome

Our last morning is devoted to exploring Bell Gorge, a hidden highlight of the West Kimberley. This idyllic retreat, considered amongst the most beautiful in the area, boasts cascading waterfalls and crystal clear pools formed over millions of years – an easy place to while away a few hours! Returning through Kimberley cattle country, we arrive back in Broome at approximately 6.30pm.

A Kimberley experience is not complete without exploring the gorges, the Bungle Bungles and local indigenous culture...

Day 1 Geikie Gorge

Visit the Old Fitzroy Crossing and Mangkaja Aboriginal Arts Centre before joining a local National Park Ranger on a guided cruise through majestic Geikie Gorge. Learn of the geology of this natural wonder and discover an array of wildlife, including

freshwater crocodiles, birds and fish. Camp by the Fitzroy River and enjoy our famous Kimberley BBQ.

Day 2 China Wall & Purnululu

Visit the gold rush town of Halls Creek and see the remarkable China Wall en route to Purnululu National Park, home of the Bungle Bungles. On arrival in Purnululu, we set up camp amidst the spectacular National Park surrounds. After a delightful bush sunset, relax with an evening meal under a canopy of stars.

Day 3 Bungle Bungles

Explore the highlights of this World Heritage National Park, including the famous Bungle Bungle domes. Rivers created this landscape of unique orange and black striped 'beehive' geological formations over a period of 20 million years. We also venture into Echidna Chasm, known for its

towering Livistonia Palm trees, and take a short walk (2-3km) into Cathedral Gorge, a natural rock amphitheatre. There is time to join a scenic flight and enjoy a birds-eye view of the beehive domes (approx \$300pp, own expense).

Day 4 Mimbi Caves

The ancient realm of Mimbi Caves is one of Australia's largest cave systems, in the heart of Gooniyandi Country. Spiritually significant, these limestone caves are one of the oldest known sites of human occupation in Australia. Delve into Dreamtime with our Gooniyandi guide who reveals the secrets of the caves, a sanctuary of clear pools, rare fossils and ancient rock art. Share fresh damper and billy tea with the traditional owners before we head for Fitzroy Crossing.

Day 5 Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek

In the heart of Bunuba Country, seek the adventure of Tunnel Creek and learn the legend of Jandamarra, an Aboriginal freedom fighter in the late



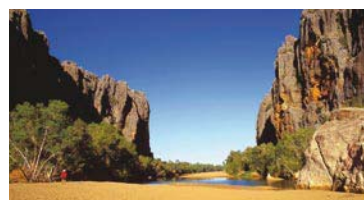
1800s. Freshen up with a swim in a waterhole before exploring rugged Windjana Gorge, an oasis in the outback. Enjoy a picnic lunch and search for freshwater crocodiles, local birdlife and bushtucker. The Gibb River Road then leads us to the Derby 'Boab Prison Tree'. Arrive back in Broome at approximately 6.30pm.

Explore the Kimberley from the savannah to the sea! Combine the Bungle Bungles with Cape Leveque on our 8 Day Spirit of the Kimberley, page 5.

freedom fighter, Jandamarra. Enjoy a swim in the waterhole, then it's off to Windjana Gorge for lunch with local freshwater crocodiles. Return to Broome via the Gibb River Road and the Boab Prison Tree. Check into your hotel for a free evening.

Day 3 Kelk Creek & Cape Leveque

Delve into a different landscape on the Dampier Peninsula. In Beagle Bay we see the beautiful pearl shell church altar, while on a visit to the Kelk

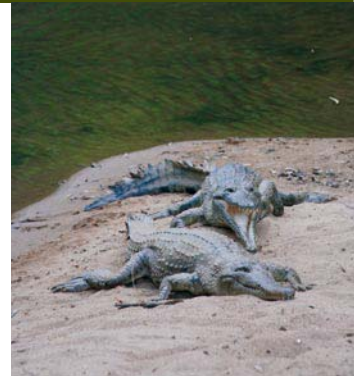
Creek Bush Retreat, our Aboriginal guide and her family introduce us to Bardi 'saltwater country' on a leisurely bushwalk. After fresh damper and billy tea, head for Cape Leveque.

Day 4 Cape Leveque

Enjoy the day at Cape Leveque as you please. You may like to join our guide on a snorkelling adventure, or you may prefer to simply enjoy the beaches and rugged red coastline.

Day 4 Geikie Gorge

Visit the Old Fitzroy Crossing and Mangkaja Aboriginal Arts Centre before joining a local National Park Ranger on a guided cruise through majestic Geikie Gorge. Camp by the Fitzroy River and enjoy a BBQ.

Day 5 China Wall & Purnululu

Via Halls Creek and China Wall, travel to Purnululu National Park, home of

the Bungle Bungles. Camping beneath a canopy of stars is the best way to really experience this remote, beautiful part of Australia.

Day 6 Bungle Bungles

Explore the highlights of this World Heritage National Park, including the famous Bungle Bungle domes, Echidna Chasm and Cathedral Gorge, a natural rock amphitheatre. There is time to join a scenic flight and enjoy a birds-eye view of the beehive domes (approx \$300pp, own expense).

Day 7 Mimbi Caves

Delve into Dreamtime with our indigenous guide who reveals the spiritual significance of Mimbi Caves, a sanctuary of clear pools, rare fossils and ancient rock art. Enjoy fresh damper and tea with the traditional Gooniyandi owners.

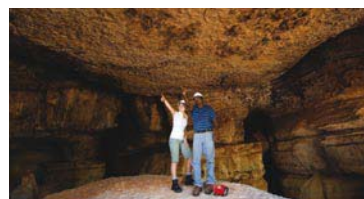
Day 8 Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek

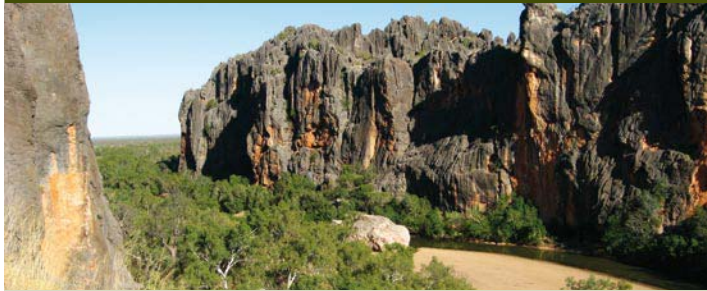

Wander with freshwater crocodiles through rugged Windjana Gorge. Freshen up with a swim amongst the water lilies at Galvins Gorge then camp by a shady billabong on Mount Barnett Cattle Station.

Day 7 Manning Falls & Silent Grove

Enjoy a morning trek into Manning Falls and swim in the waterfall pools. Travel via Adcock Gorge to Silent Grove where we camp in the shadow of the King Leopold Ranges.

Day 8 Bell Gorge & Broome

Considered amongst the most beautiful in the area, Bell Gorge boasts cascading waterfalls and crystal clear pools. Returning through cattle country, we arrive back in Broome at approximately 6.30pm.
