Kooljaman at Cape Leveque is a unique wilderness style luxury camp on the tip of the Dampier Peninsula, 220km north of Broome. It is jointly owned by Djarindjin and One Arm Point Aboriginal communities.

Here you can enjoy a diverse range of nature based experiences including; gorgeous sunrises and sunsets, swimming in azure waters, photography, beachcombing, bush tucker tours, spectacular walks, whale watching and bird spotting.

The more adventurous can try out mud crabbing, scenic flights over the Buccaneer Archipelago, snorkelling, charter boat trips, tag-a-long 4WD tours, cultural tours and fishing. There is also our most popular pastime - doing nothing at all but soaking up the sheer tranquility and beauty of all that surrounds.

FACILITIES INCLUDE

Dinkas Restaurant - open most evenings from Easter thru mid October. Alfresco style dining with beautiful views, serving takeaway lunch and dinner and counter style evening meals. Safari Tents

Not to be confused with traditional camping! These huge tents are built high on the hillside with unobstructed panoramic ocean views. Set up with a queen and two single sized beds, all tents have their own bathrooms and kitchenettes. Each tent has a huge Jarrah deck, quality fixtures and fittings throughout, tea & coffee facilities, full size fridge/freezer, and a gourmet gas barbecue on the veranda. Bath towels and bed linen supplied.

En-suite Cabins

The open plan en-suite cabins have a double bed and three single beds along with their own bathroom. Each cabin has a fridge/freezer, tea and coffee facilities, ceiling fans, outdoor setting and barbecue. Bath towels and bed linen supplied.

Log Cabins

Constructed out of bush poles with big opening shutters, most have beautiful views and are no more than 100 metres to the water's edge. Each cabin has one queen size bed and two single beds. Bathroom facilities are shared between two cabins. Each cabin has a fridge/freezer, tea and coffee facilities, ceiling fans, outdoor setting and barbecue. Bath towels and bed linen supplied.

Units

Located within the campground, these basic units contain ceiling fans, fridge/freezer, tea and coffee facilities, comfortable beds and bed linen. There is an outdoor setting and gas barbecue at each unit. Ablution facilities are located nearby and shared with the campers. Bath towels and bed linen supplied.

Mini Safari Tents

Located at the rear of the campground, each tent is setup with a double or twin beds, lamp, fan and a deck with outdoor chairs. Cooking and ablution facilities are shared with the campers. Linen hire available.

Beach Camping Shelters

Hugely popular, these shelters are located near the water's edge. Ideal for those who enjoy a unique and private camping experience, with facilities close at hand. Constructed from bush poles and covered with a combination of thatching and palm fronds. Each shelter has a picnic table, fresh water shower, wood barbecue and shared ablution facilities nearby.

Campground

Our lovely tree filled campground has communal shady pergolas, well maintained ablutions, BBQ's and a guest laundry. Some sites enjoy delightful views of the western beach. Power available for camp fridges and lighting only.
