Kimberley Camping Tours 4WD Camping Safaris

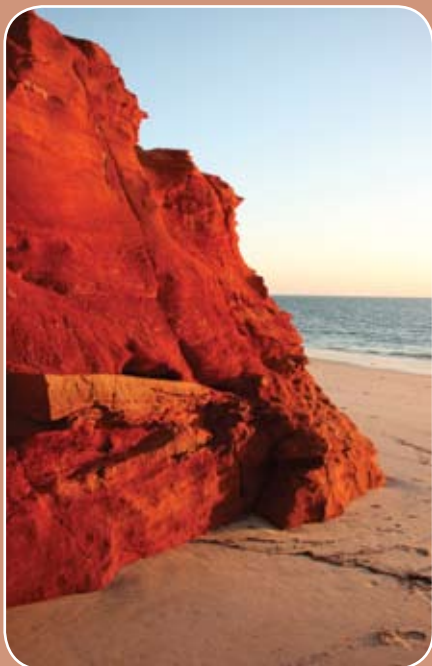


This tour incorporates all of the major icons of the Kimberley that are the real pearls.

Starting in Broome we traverse the sandy track to the stunning and remote Cape Leveque. On arrival we will have the opportunity to take a walk along the beach swim or relax by the ocean. Watch the sandstone cliffs change colour as the sun sets over the ocean.

We make our way across the mighty Fitzroy River, visit the Prison Tree then on to the Gibb River road. We will explore the magnificent gorges of this area including a visit to Windjana Gorge, Tunnel Creek, Manning Gorge and Galvins Gorge. We also visit Drysdale Station and experience a real working cattle property. Experience the spectacular Mitchell Falls and take an optional helicopter ride over the falls, before arriving at El Questro. We spend two nights at El Questro with time to explore the scenic gorges and relax in the thermal hot springs.

Onto Kununurra with a free day to explore the town take a cruise or enjoy an optional flight. Travel to world renowned Purnululu National Park where we will enjoy short walks while camping inside the National Park. Some may choose to take an optional helicopter flight over this natural wonder. A cruise along the Geikie Gorge before we finish the tour at Broome.

Your Agent:

Day 1: Broome – Cape Leveque

Departing Broome we travel a sandy track through to Cape Leveque. On arrival we will have the opportunity to take a walk along the beach, swim or relax by the ocean. Camp Cape Leveque (LD)

Day 2: Cape Leveque – Windjana Gorge

Depart Cape Leveque and make our way across the mighty Fitzroy River. Visit the Prison Tree and Tunnel Creek where water has worn a tunnel beneath the limestone of the Napier Range. You can walk 750 metres through the tunnel to the other side of Napier Range, wading through several permanent pools and watching for bats. Our evening is spent at Windjana Gorge. Bush camp Windjana Gorge (BLD)

Day 3: Windjana Gorge – Manning Gorge

After a morning walk along Windjana Gorge, see the fresh water crocodiles as they laze on the bank. A short walk to Galvins Gorge provides a fantastic location for lunch with time to cool off under the waterfall. We travel through to Manning Gorge where we can enjoy a swim in the river. Bush camp Manning Gorge (BLD)

Day 4: Manning Gorge – King Edward River

After an early swim or walk we continue along the rugged Gibb River Road. We follow the Kalumburu Road to the King Edward River. Camping beside the river will provide everyone with a chance to freshen up with a dip in the clear water or a relax beside the falls. Bush camp King Edward River (BLD)

Day 5: Kind Edward River – Mitchell Falls

Travelling along the remote, rough and narrow track we make our way along the plateau and take in the spectacular scenery as we pass the Livistonia Palms and amazing lookouts. Walk to little Mertens Falls, view amazing Bradshaw Art and then onto the famous Mitchell Falls. There is an opportunity to enjoy an optional helicopter flight over this amazing country. Bush camp Mitchell Falls (BLD)

Day 6: Mitchell Falls – Drysdale Station

Morning walk followed by the opportunity to view aboriginal Wandjina and Bradshaw paintings. Overnight camp at Drysdale Station with a chance for a cold drink at Annie's Bar and experience what it is like on a working cattle property. (BLD)

Day 7: Drysdale Stn – El Questro

Today takes us along the Gibb River Road toward world renowned El Questro. Visit amazing lookouts with a chance for an evening drink at the bar or freshen off with a swim in the creek. Camp El Questro (BLD)

Day 8: El Questro - Kununurra

After breakfast we have the opportunity to enjoy a dip at Zebedee Springs a hot thermal pool surrounded by Livistonia Palms. Walk El Questro Gorge swim in the clear water or enjoy the falls. After leaving El Questro we finish the final leg of the Gibb before making our way to Kununurra. Those passengers on our 8 day and 'Icons of the Kimberley' tours will depart the tour on arrival in Kununurra, with drop offs at local hotels (BL)

Day 9: Kununurra

A morning town tour visiting Ivanhoe Crossing and a Mellon Farm before have the rest of the day free to explore Kununurra and the surrounding areas. Scenic Flights, JJJ Boat Cruise, fishing, canoeing and swimming are among the activities you may consider. Camp Kununurra (B)

Day 10: Kununurra – Purnululu NP

Today our “Bungles Adventure” and ‘Icons of the Kimberley’ tour passengers will be collected on our way out of town. We travel south to Purnululu National Park to see the Bungle Bungles. We travel along rugged 4WD tracks before setting up camp late in the afternoon. Bush Camp Bungles (BLD)

Day 11: Purnululu NP

Explore Picanniny Creek, Cathedral Gorge and Echidna Chasm. Lots of short walks with some of the most spectacular scenery to ever be seen. Today there is the option for a scenic Helicopter flight to experience it all from the air. Bush Camp Bungles (BLD)

Day 12: Purnululu NP – Fitzroy River

After a morning walk, we travel on to Fitzroy River and enjoy our camp beside the river. Camp Fitzroy River (BLD)

Day 13: Fitzroy River - Broome

A morning Geikie Gorge Cruise provides a great way to experience the mighty Fitzroy River. Learn about the history and marvel in the birdlife along the river. We then travel along the Great Northern Road passing huge Boab trees. We complete our expedition in Broome with drop offs to local hotels. (BL). Those passengers on our 'Icons of the Kimberley' tour will have dinner at own expense and two free days in Broome before being collected the following day.
